Why do I need Simoniz[®] GlassCoat[™]?

Simple. GlassCoat[™] provides coverage to your paint that you do not get from the manufacturer.

How is my paint not covered by the manufacturer?

- Things like acid rain, tree sap, bird waste, decaying insects, hard water, ice melting agents, and UV damage from the sun are specifically excluded by the manufacturer's warranty.
- Paints are water soluble now and much softer than paints of the past. That's good for the environment, but requires more care of the vehicle.
- The softer the paint, the more easily it can be damaged.

How does GlassCoat[™] protect my vehicle?

 GlassCoat[™] is a clear liquid that is applied to the clear coat of your vehicle. Unlike traditional waxes, polishes, or sealants that cover the surface temporarily, GlassCoat[™] reacts with hydrogen and oxygen to form a permanent glass-like coating.

The end result is an extremely clear, tough and durable ceramic film that adheres strongly to the clear coat.







What guarantee do I have that GlassCoat[™] will protect my vehicle?

- When professionally applied, GlassCoat[™] polymerizes the clear coat of your vehicle and forms a unique ceramic glass resin.
- To back up our GlassCoat[™] product, we provide you with a LIFETIME* product warranty on new vehicles and up to 6 years on used vehicles. If the process fails, the warranty will repair or repaint your vehicle.



Interior Protection

How about the interior of my car?

 Simoniz[®] uses Dupont[™] Teflon[®] Surface Protector's unique properties in a process that is applied to the seats, floor mats, inside door panels, and carpeting of your vehicle. This process protects your interior from stains from food products, food dye, lipstick, makeup, vomit, crayons, urine, blood, ink and clothing dyes. If the process fails, the warranty will repair or reupholster your vehicle carpeting or seats.

Rental Car
